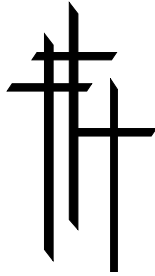
The Liturgy Committee is looking for children (5 or older) to participate in the Christmas Service. They are in need of:

Dear Members of the SSCM Faith Community,

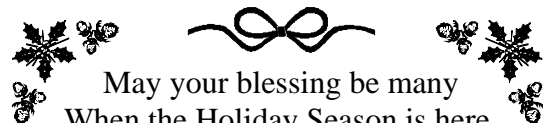
